Note: The U.S. Department of Education does not recognize Emancipation of a MS Resident as being valid to establish independent student status for Federal Student Aid.
Documentation: Attach a copy of a court's decision of your emancipated minor status.
I am or I was in legal guardianship. Check this box only if:
 A. You can provide a copy of a court's decision that as of today you are in legal guardianship, or B. You can provide a copy of a court's decision that you were in legal guardianship immediately before you reached the age of being an adult in your state.
Note: For (A) and (B), the court must be located in your state of legal residence at the time the court's decision was issued.
Documentation: If (A) above applies to you, attach a copy of Letters of Guardianship. If (B) above applies to you, attach a copy of the court's Order of Discharge from Guardianship.

*Requirement: Correct the information on your FAFSA by providing your parent(s) financial information on your Student Aid Report (SAR). You will receive a corrected SAR from the federal processor and the corrected information will be transmitted electronically to the Financial Aid Office.
