Where are we in the project?

Move to Production activities underway for upcoming Workday Student Recruiting and Admissions go-live on June 1st. The training team is finishing up WDS 101: Workday Student Recruiting training and will move to Admissions training. The Cashnet implementation is continuing. Configuration continues for Milestone 2 – will include Curriculum Management and first wave of Financial Aid functionality

One of the duties of the Workday Integrations Team is to look for ways to enhance and optimize UMMC’s Workday implementation. Since April 2nd, UMMC’s supply chain team has printed over 10,000 goods delivery labels. The Integrations Team, working with our implementation partner Accenture, analyzed that label printing process. They identified a way to optimize that process saving about 5 seconds per label. That optimization has been put in place. As we proceed with moving out Student Systems into Workday, your Workday Team will continue to look for opportunities to save time and money.
