JACKSON, Miss. – With the help of Nickelodeon star SpongeBob SquarePants, BankPlus presented a check for \$148,785.40 to Friends of Children's Hospital, representing the first year's proceeds from the bank's Friends of Children's Hospital CheckCard program.
