Dr. Brian H. Williams was born in Chicopee, MA. A self-described Air Force brat, he has traveled and lived around the world. After graduating from the United States Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs, CO, he served six years active duty as an aeronautical engineer. Answering a call to medicine, he left the Air Force to attend medical school at the University of South Florida College of Medicine. He completed his residency in general surgery at Brigham and Women's Hospital, a teaching hospital of Harvard Medical School in Boston, MA. He finished his training with a fellowship in trauma surgery and surgical critical care at Grady Memorial Hospital, a teaching hospital of Emory University School of Medicine in Atlanta, GA.

In 2010, Dr. Williams joined the faculty of UT Southwestern Medical Center in Dallas, TX, and is now an Associate Professor of Surgery. He was recently named the General Surgery Residency Program Director at UT Southwestern, where he also spends his time teaching and mentoring medical students, surgery residents, and fellows. In addition to these roles, he is a staff surgeon specializing in trauma surgery, emergency surgery, and surgical critical care at Parkland Memorial Hospital.
