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The Master of Health Informatics and Information Management

(HIIM) prepares graduates for a wide range of leadership roles, including electronic health record management, implementation support specialist, corporate compliance, patient engagement, and data analytics and reporting. Students learn how to develop and implement enterprise data management tools that enable clinicians to achieve better quality healthcare outcomes while addressing the need for information security, information governance, and regulatory compliance.

Application Deadline:

March 1 for fall admission.

Admission Requirements:

In addition to the admission standards of the institution and the general admission requirements of the School of Health Related Professions, candidates seeking admission must:

1. Have a bachelor's degree from a regionally-accredited institution of higher learning with a GPA of at least 3.00 on a 4.00 scale on the last 60 hours attempted.
2. Submit an official GRE report.
3. Submit a résumé.
4. Submit an essay.
5. Successfully complete (grade of "C" or better) a course in human anatomy and physiology or a pre-approved substitute.
