## **Physical Therapy Faculty Position - Pediatrics**

The Physical Therapy Department of the School of Health Related Professions at the University of Mississippi Medical Center invites applications for 12-month nontenure track faculty position for the Doctor of Physical Therapy program. Candidates should have a clinical doctorate with preference being given to candidates with an academic doctorate and/or a specialty certification through the American Board of Physical Therapy Specialties, and be eligible for physical therapy licensure in the state of Mississippi. Successful candidates should have clinical expertise in the practice of pediatric physical therapy examination, evaluation, and intervention, and demonstrate expertise in teaching. The potential to conduct clinical research and obtain external funding is desirable. Rank and salary are commensurate with experience and academic background.

Physical therapy is one of ten departments within the School of Health Related Professions which is located on the University of Mississippi Medical Center campus. The physical therapy program boasts a collegial faculty that is committed to academic excellence, ongoing scholarly endeavors, clinical practice, and team teaching. The qualified successful candidate will have the responsibility of teaching content in the pediatric track within the entry-level DPT curriculum and in other areas as assigned. Additionally, there are opportunities for educational and clinical contributions to the residency program in pediatric physical therapy. The pediatric residency is in candidacy status, and has recently undergone a site visit by the ABPTRFE for initial accreditation.
